Summary

The 2009 Medications and Pregnancy Symposium will provide a venue for the exchange of knowledge on the risks and benefits of medication use during pregnancy for the mother and child. As Health Canada does not permit the inclusion of pregnant women in clinical trials, data on the safety of drug exposure during pregnancy prior to the medication being available on the market are scarce. This one-day event will be useful to Quebec's general practitioners, paediatricians, obstetricians, pharmacists and nurses in Quebec providing healthcare services to pregnant women, as well as researchers and graduate students/fellows in perinatology.

1. The prescription of teratogens during pregnancy: When is it necessary and when should it be avoided?
2. Pregnancy and HIV.
